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3.3 SEAT ALLOTMENT CATEGORIES

- 1. Government Quota:** 50% of the total seats in B Tech programmes are set apart as Govt. Quota for centralized allotment by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations, Govt. of Kerala (KEAM).
- 2. Management Quota:** 35% of the seats are allotted under management quota on the basis of merit list of the applicants based on the marks obtained in +2 examination and engineering entrance examination (KEAM/JEE).
- 3. NRI Quota:** 15% of the seats are allotted to NRI category based on norms and procedures published from time to time by concerned authorities.

3.4 ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Nationality:** Candidates must be Citizens of India.
- 2) Academic Requirements:** Pass in Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or an examination recognized equivalent there to with at least 45% (Forty Five) marks in Mathematics separately and 45% (Forty Five) marks in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry/equivalent subjects put together or equivalent grade.
- 3) Entrance Examination:** Candidates generally must qualify in the KEAM exam conducted by the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations (CEE), Govt. of Kerala. Alternatively, qualifying scores in JEE Main are also accepted.
- 4) NRI allotment:** Score in the entrance is not required for NRI allotment. However they have to fulfil the academic eligibility as per norms.
- 5) Age:** Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as of date of application. No relaxation of age will be allowed.

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5. FACILITIES

CENTRAL LIBRARY

The Library and Information centre of STM is one of the best engineering college libraries in Malabar area. It started its function with a vision to serve the information needs of its users and mainly hold books related to engineering and allied subjects. The library collection is about 16700 Volumes and 7000 titles at present. It offers a fully integrated and dynamic environment for conducting academic reference. Multiple copies ensure that resources are adequately available in the Reference Section and Stock Section as well. The library has been fully automated, digitized and Open Access System is followed and Online Public Access Catalogue service is made available to all faculties and students. The college has an institutional membership with DELNET New Delhi. Through DELNET, staff and students can access more than 1150 e-journals and 2000 e-books related to engineering and technology. Through KNIMBUS Platform staff and students can access more than 900 e-journals and 30 printed journals through I Manager publications. The college also has subscription to various Engineering journals including IEEE journals which can help the student in expanding their education horizon beyond what is taught in the classrooms. The college central library is a member of National Digital Library of India (NDLI).

CENTRAL COMPUTING FACILITY

The College has a well-established computer centre with latest computer hardware, software, servers and state of the art networking. It provides access to all staff and students. The total number of workstations and servers are more than 250 with high speed Internet facility. The institution is supported by high-speed internet connectivity through three 100 Mbps broadband connections, one 80 Mbps broadband connection, and a 300 Mbps leased-line connection, ensuring reliable and uninterrupted network access.

LANGUAGE LAB

English Language is considered to be the common language globally and as the window to the modern technological world. A language lab has been set up to improve the communication skills of the students. Students acquire proficiency in English by going through the self-learning software modules. Students can develop their written and oral communication skills and take up the competitive examination with confidence. The college has a well-equipped language lab with an adequate number of systems, internet connectivity and ENTL software to train the students.

TRANSPORTATION

To ensure hassle free transportation to staffs and students in time, at present 14 college buses are plying in and around Kannur district covering important locations such as Kannur Town, Thazhe Chovva,



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Thalassery, Iritty, Kuthuparamba, Panoor, Chalode, Peravoor, Thottada, Eachur, Koodali, Mattanur, Uruvachal, Kadirur, Kakkayangad, Anjarakandy, Chakkarakkal, Pandakkal, Palloor, Mekkunnu, Edakkad, Chala, Mambaram, Kannur Airport, Mayyil, Chavassery, Chokli etc. Additional feasible routes will be added as per the requirements of students, then and there.

STUDENT HOSTEL

College hostel resembles a home away from home atmosphere. The college provides excellent, well-furnished and comfortable hostel accommodation separately for outstation boys and girls with strict overall supervision of the Warden and Teaching staff. Resident Tutors and Wardens of each hostel take care of adherence to rules & regulations in the hostel.

CAMPUS MANAGEMENT SYSTEM SOFTWARE

The Campus Management System – Linways AMS - serves as an integrated platform for managing the academic and administrative functions of the institution. It streamlines processes such as student registration, attendance recording, evaluation details, exam results, and recording of student and faculty data. The system also enables effective communication, report generation, and resource management, thereby improving accuracy, reducing time, manual effort, and enhancing the overall efficiency of academic operations.

TRAINING AND PLACEMENT CELL

Moulding engineers is not the sole responsibility of St. Thomas College of Engineering & Technology. It is an important aspect of the educational philosophy of our institution to supplement its students with exposure to soft skills and research. 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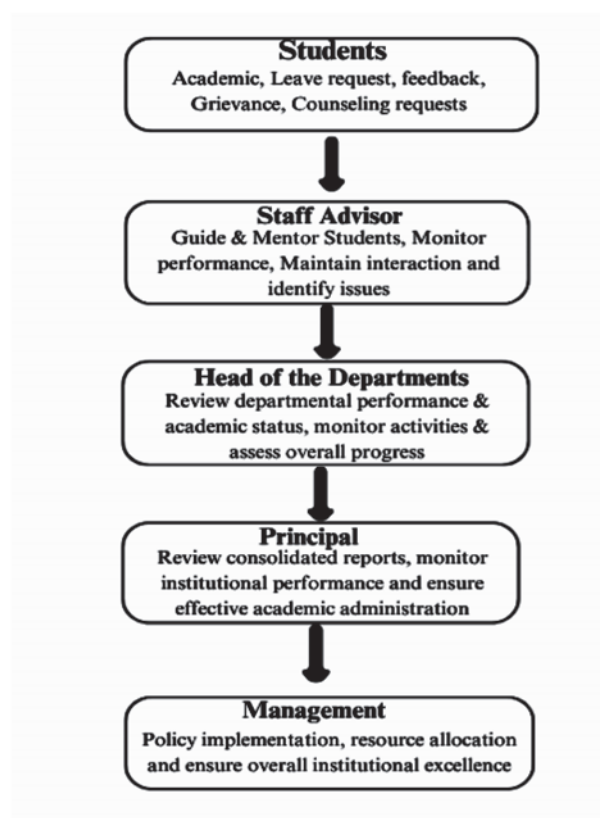

STUDENT REPORTING SYSTEM

The Student Reporting System at STM follows a structured hierarchical framework comprising Students, Staff Advisors/Mentors, Heads of Departments (HoDs), Principal, and CEO. The system enables continuous monitoring and reporting of student attendance, academic performance, counselling activities, and overall progress at various levels. Staff Advisors and Mentors provide guidance and maintain regular interaction with students, while HoDs review departmental performance and academic status. The Principal and Management utilize the consolidated reports for decision-making, planning, policy implementation, and ensuring effective academic administration and student support mechanisms within the institution.



CAFETERIA

The college has a spacious canteen facility in the college campus and is run by college management. A variety of south Indian food and snack items are provided to the students and staff of the college at highly subsidized rates with highest quality. Our college canteen provides a family atmosphere, with a variety of delicacies, touched by a homemade flavour, cooked to perfection and served with great courtesy. Water purifiers and coolers are available at every floor. Refreshments are available at the college canteen at affordable rates. The main canteen has more than 400 seating capacity and the lunch hall has over 150 capacity with staff and students separate space to accommodate even at peak time.

6. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COLLEGE

1. Official working hours of the college will be between 8.30 AM to 4.45 PM on all days from Monday to Friday, except Govt. notified public holidays.
2. Classes will commence at 8.50 AM and ends at 4.40 PM. Classes will be conducted as per the Academic schedule published from time to time, at par with the KTU academic calendar.
3. All students are expected to be in the respective classrooms by 8.45 AM.
4. Students are directed to adhere to the uniform dress code prescribed by the institution. The ID card should be well displayed whenever they are inside the college campus.
5. Students shall be present in their classrooms before the commencement of each period and shall not be permitted to leave the class during the class hours. However, on specific request from the Principal/Competent authorities, faculty may permit a student or students to leave the class as requested.
6. Students are not permitted to leave the campus between 8.45 AM and 4.40 PM without prior permission from the Principal/HOD.
7. Students are required to be regular in attending classes and completing the academic works assigned to them by the faculty. Registration for End Semester Examinations will be subject to the attendance and academic minimum requirements, prescribed by the university.
8. Prior sanction from the Head of Department should be obtained for all absence (except certain emergency situations) from the class, through proper leave application. For absence of more than two days, the leave application must be endorsed by the Parent/Guardian. Leave on medical grounds should be supported with proper medical certificates. Unauthorized absence will be viewed seriously and are liable for disciplinary actions.
9. Use of mobile phones in the college campus is restricted. However it is strictly prohibited in classrooms, laboratories, and other academic spaces (keep in switch off mode), unless permitted by the concerned faculty for academic purpose. Unlawful use of mobile phones while inside the campus, the same will be confiscated and will be returned only after paying a fine of Rs 2000/- to the college office, with the presence of the parents. For urgent communication with parents/guardians, the land phone facility available at the college office may be used.
10. Malpractices, use of mobile phones and other electronic gadgets (for receiving, storing, transmitting) are strictly banned in examination halls. Failure to do so will attract serious punishments as per university rules and regulations.



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11. Abstaining from classes en-masse will be considered as a serious offence and will invite suitable actions.
12. College properties should be handled with maximum care and everything possible should be done to preserve the building, furniture and premises neat, tidy and fit. College will be forced to impose a fine on wilful damages to the buildings, fittings, furniture or equipment.
13. Keep the campus neat and clean. Do not put any waste anywhere in the campus except in the waste baskets kept for the same.
14. Students are not generally permitted to bring private vehicles, owned or hired, inside the campus. However, day scholars desirous of commuting to and fro for attending the college can do so by making a request to the Principal in writing, authorized by their parents and submit copies of the registration documents of the vehicle and valid driving license. Such vehicles should be parked at the space allowed near the entrance of the campus.
15. Students are directed to go through the laws related to Prevention of Ragging in the educational institution. Ragging in any form at any place is totally prohibited. Apart from those who are engaged in the actual act of ragging but those who are found to be assisting or supporting, shall be considered to be associated with ragging and are liable to be punishable as per law.
16. Any incident of ragging within or outside the campus should be reported to the Principal/CEO for subsequent report to the police. Ragging is a strictly prohibited criminal offense in India, governed by the national **University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations** and state-level laws, such as the **Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act**. Conviction leads to severe disciplinary actions, including immediate suspension, dismissal from the institution etc (Refer Act).
17. Organizing meetings or assembling students within the campus for purposes other than academics, is strictly prohibited. Prior permission of the Principal shall be obtained for such gatherings. All political activities are prohibited inside the college campus.
18. Possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, drugs etc. are strictly prohibited in the college and hostel campus.
19. Students who happen to have free hours shall not loiter in the verandas during class hours or disturb other classes.
20. Every student shall bring his/her own textbooks, notebook, drawing instruments and such other accessories and articles required for regular classroom/laboratory work.
21. Cordial relationships shall be maintained among the students and with members of the staff working in the college and cooperation extended to them in serving you better. Students shall not enter into



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any kind of arguments or disputes among themselves or with the staff members. Complaints, if any, shall be brought to the attention of the Principal/CEO.

22. Students are not allowed to entertain visitors inside the college during working hours. However visitors may contact the students at the area near the reception with the permission of the Principal.
23. All are expected to actively participate in the co-curricular/extra-curricular activities organized at the college.
24. All students should conduct themselves in a dignified manner with a high degree of discipline and professionalism at all times, at all places, which enable them to mould themselves to take up positions of responsibilities in future.
25. The rules and regulations may be modified or may be added as deemed necessary, for institutional excellence.
26. Principal/CEO decisions in all matters regarding the functioning of the college shall be final and has the right to change content/rules from time to time.



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7. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Innovation And Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC)

The Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development Centre (IEDC) is an initiative of Kerala Start-up Mission under Start-up Boot camp Scheme of Government of Kerala. Under this scheme financial assistance is given to selected colleges for supporting innovative products and thereby builds an entrepreneurial ecosystem inside the campus.

STM IEDC has established a well-equipped IoT lab. STM IEDC Chapter has won several achievements including, 1st Prize in StartUp i3 (2 times), Shortlisted for Project Presentation at Kerala's Biggest Start-Up SME Conclave (Green Room), shortlisted for the final stage of Project Competition conducted by KTU etc. This IEDC chapter is conducting several activities including hands-on workshop on website development, IoT workshop, Out of Syllabus –experience sharing session, Logo design competition, workshops, seminars etc.

National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL)

NPTEL (National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning), a project funded by the Ministry of Human Resource Development is a joint initiative of the IITs and IISc. NPTEL has been offering self-study courses across engineering, humanities and science streams for more than a decade. Our institution has established a dedicated NPTEL local chapter which enables us to establish a fruitful relationship with the NPTEL nodal office and other participating colleges. NPTEL tutorials are made available in college intranet. A student who qualifies the NPTEL Exam will get certificates from IITs. Many students already received 'Elite' category certificates for their good performance.

IEEE Student Branch

An IEEE Student Branch gives students a community of peers, and a connection to faculty and industry professionals who drive innovation in countless technical fields. Student involvement in Branch activities, whether special projects, social and technical meetings, outreach programmes, conferences, local Section or Regional opportunities, etc. can help develop a record of accomplishment and capabilities beyond the norm.

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10. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CENTRAL LIBRARY

10.1 General Rules

- Library shall remain open on all working days with the timing
 - i. Monday to Friday- 8:30 am to 6:30 pm
 - ii. Saturday- 8.30 am to 4.00 pm
- Strict silence should be maintained at all time
- Students are expected to behave in a responsible manner in the library.
- Each user will be provided with library cards for the issue of books.
- Each student would be issued two books at a time for a period of one week.
- Re-issue of books to a user may be allowed up to twice more after the first issue.
- Examine the borrowed books carefully before you leave the library.
- Students shall handle library materials carefully. Any damage done shall have to be rectified.
- Failure to return the books on due date, would compulsorily lead to a penalty.
- ‘No dues’ certificate is to be obtained from the librarian for submitting it to the authorities, as and when required to do so.
- Magazines and periodicals will be issued for a week only.
- Students are allowed to enter the library only on production of their authorized valid Identity Cards.

10.2 Books Circulation

Issue System: Books will be issued on presentation of the library card. Students are responsible for any type of damage or mutilation noticed at the time of return.

Overdue Charges: Books will be issued to the students for 14 days only. In the first page of each book, slip is pasted and return due date will be stamped on it. For late submission beyond due date, a fine of Rs.1 per day per book will be charged from the due date till the book is returned.

Book Lost: If the books are lost, then the borrower shall replace the books of the same edition or latest edition or pay three times the cost of the book, after getting permission from the librarian.

Care of Library Borrower Cards: Take special care to maintain the library borrower cards. Do not fold/alter the entries made on the cards and members are responsible for the entire set of library borrower cards issued to them.

Care of Library Books: Students are required to handle the books/ Journal very carefully; marking with pencil, writing or highlighting , tearing the pages or mutilating the same in any other way will be

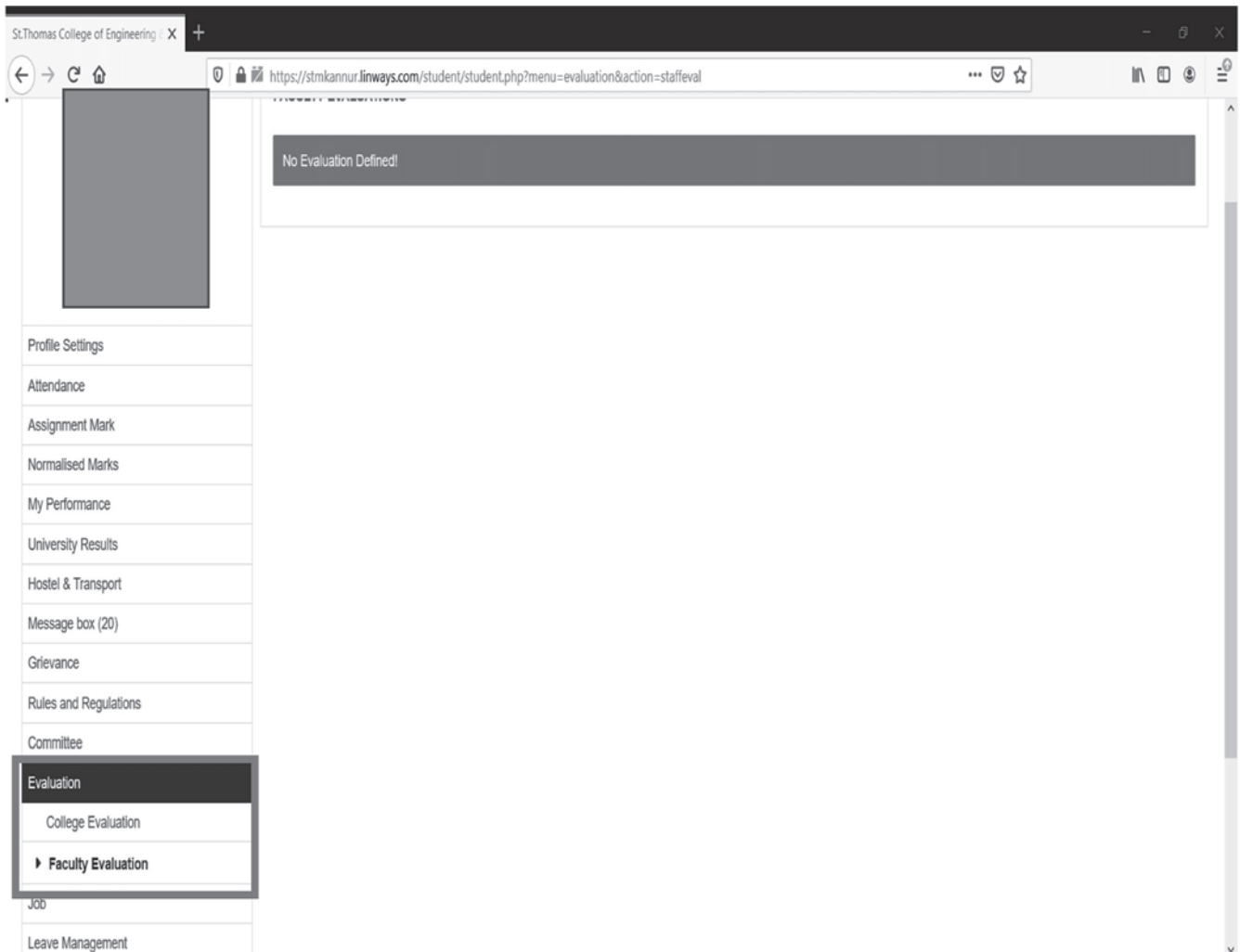
